NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting at 9755 Landry Boulevard, Spring, Harris County, Texas, said address being an office and meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Monday, November 11, 2024, at 4:30 p.m.

The subject of the meeting will be to consider and take such actions as the Board may deem appropriate in connection with the following:


1. Comments from the public (the Board imposes a three-minute speaking limit for each member of the public wishing to address the Board; comments will be closed after this item);
2. Approval of the minutes of the October 14, 2024, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Consider review of proposals for solid waste collection and recycling services;
4. Status of solid waste collection services by Texas Pride Disposal, including review and approval of Amendment to Residential Solid Waste Collection Contract, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
5. Financial and investment reports, including invoices presented, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
6. Consider annual review of Order Establishing Policy for Investment of District Funds and Appointing Investment Officer, and adoption of Resolution in connection therewith;
7. Report on status of collection of taxes, the status of collection of delinquent tax accounts, and the payment of invoices in connection therewith, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith, including authorizing the termination of water service to the properties of delinquent taxpayers;
8. Report on District's water, sanitary sewer and storm sewer systems, including:
  - a) Customer appeals of District charges or policies;
  - b) Compliance with District permits;
  - c) Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities, including repair of drainage swale in Stonebrook Estates;
  - d) Authorizing delinquent accounts to be turned over for collection or written off;
  - e) Status of permit violation issued by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;
  - f) Authorization of repair and maintenance of storm sewer facilities relative to the manhole survey performed in Stonebrook Estates, and request from reimbursement from the Stonebrook Estates Community Association;
  - g) Status of collection of repair fees from Ezee Fiber relative to service tubing damages;
  - h) Status of report from Environmental Allies relative to East and West Detention Ponds;
  - i) Status of disconnection of electricity service to the guard light at Water Plant No. 1;
